Dear parents/carers,

Welcome back to the final half-term of the school year. You will see from the dates section at the end of the newsletter, that we have a busy few weeks. Year 6 have started their three-day residential at Robinwood today and we will be updating Facebook with photos each evening.

Phonics Screening Check – This week the Year 1 children will be taking their phonics check. Please ensure that your child is in school and on time on Thursday and Friday.

Multiplication Timetables Check – This week the children in Year 4 will take the multiplication timestables check (MTC). This is an online test of multiplication facts. The children will take this test throughout the week.

Sun cream – We are expecting the weather to be hot all week. Please can you apply sun cream to your children before coming into school. All our classrooms have air-conditioning to keep the children cool and they will take their water bottles outside at break times. Children will be directed to shady parts of the playground if they are too hot.

School uniform - We are always interested in gathering parent views about school life. We are proposing one addition and one change to our school uniform and would like to gather your views.

We are proposing to introduce a school hoodie that is the same colour and approximately the same price as the school jumper.
