
Challenge: Can you decorate and fill an 'All About Me' bag?

We will have show and tell Friday for the children to show and share their work on Tapestry. Thank you for your support.




We are going to be reading many books about school, family and ourselves. We will learn that some books are non-fiction texts, and these books give us information.
