<p>Maths (You must complete this activity).</p> <p>Count forwards and backwards to 100 in ones. Count in 2s up to 30 forwards and backwards. Count in 5s up to 100 forwards and backwards. Count in 10s up to 100 forwards and backwards.</p>	<p>English Writing, Grammar, Punctuation or Spelling. (You must complete this activity).</p> <p>The children will be bringing home word cards. These will be a mixture of words they can sound out and words that they can't. The children should be able to read these words eventually with no sounding out. Please practise daily. The children will also be bringing home some reading activities and/or grammar activities every Monday and these need completing and handing in the following Monday.</p>	<p>English – Reading (You must complete this activity).</p> <p>The children will bring home 2 reading books which will be changed twice a week. Your child's changing days are on the inside cover of their reading diary. The children should be reading daily. Encourage your child to sound out the words using the sounds they know. They also need to be listening to themselves as they read to help with understanding. The reading books should be brought to school every day.</p>
