

I am the pread that has come down from heaven

The Holy Eucharist is central to the life of the Church. It is the fuel that fires her to move on in her life of witnessing despite the tribulations that the church passes through. "The Church draws her life from the Eucharist," as Pope St. John Paul II said at the start of his encyclical "Ecclesia de Eucharistia." According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 1324). "The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life." This runs in the thoughts of the early church Fathers who taught that one should receive the Eucharist with faith thus: "The bread and the wine of the Eucharist before the holy invocation of the adorable Trinity were simple bread and wine, but the invocation having been made, the bread becomes the body of Christ and the wine the blood of Christ" (Catechetical Lectures 19:7 [A.D. 350]).

On today's feast, the Lord Jesus declares "I am the Living bread which has come down from heaven." In other words, the Eucharist is his real body. There is a real presence of Jesus there. It is not just a symbol, but Jesus really present for us. He is our bread, the food of our life. With him in us and we in him, our life is assured.
