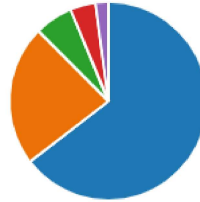

1. My child is happy at this school. (0 point)

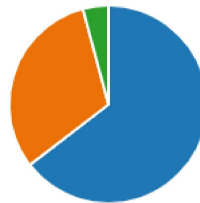

2. My child feels safe at this school. (0 point)

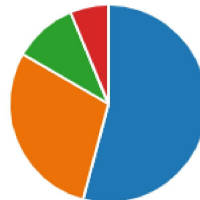

3. This school makes sure that pupils are well-behaved. (0 point)

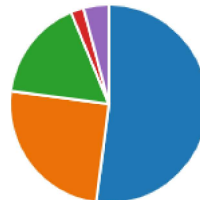

4. Is bullying a problem in this school? (0 point)

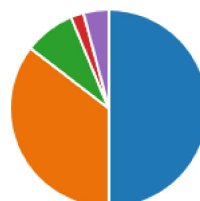

5. This school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the school year. (0 point)

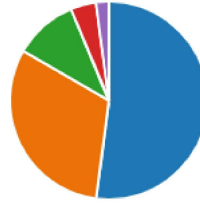

6. When I have raised concerns with school they have been dealt with properly. (0 point)

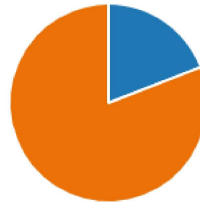

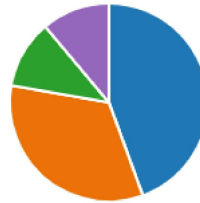

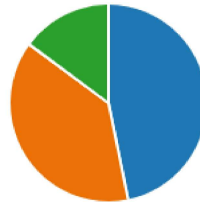

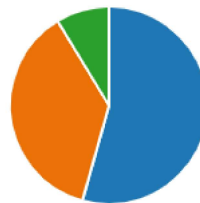

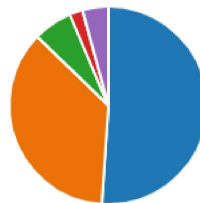

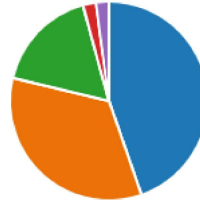

13. The school supports my child's wider personal development. (0 point)

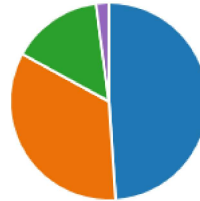

14. The school supports my child's well-being. (0 point)

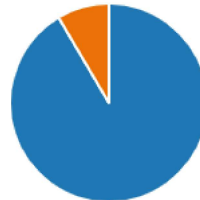
