Maths (You must complete this activity).	English Writing, Grammar, Punctuation or Spelling. (You must complete this activity).	English – Reading (You must complete this activity).
Use 10 objects from your home (this could be anything – 10 grapes, 10 building blocks, 10 shoes etc.) Make 10 in front of you in as many different ways as possible. e.g. 5 grapes + 5 grapes = 10 grapes.	Draw a picture of what you think Little Red Riding Hood looks like. Write words around the picture which tell us about her, for example, bright red hood, friendly smile. If you would like to, put these words into some sentences to describe what Red Riding Hood is like.	The children will bring home reading books which will be changed at least once per week. Please listen to your child read daily and encourage them to sound out the words using the sounds they know. They also need to be listening to themselves as they read to help with understanding. The reading books should be brought to school every day.
