<p>Maths (You must complete this activity).</p> <p>The children should know their times tables and division facts up to 12 x 12. These are tested every Friday. The children should be accessing TTRS daily.</p>	<p>English Writing, Grammar, Punctuation or Spelling. 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Geography


In geography our topic is water cycle
